INTRODUCTION TO FEDERAL LAWS & POLICY

Course Description: The purpose of this course is to introduce students to the Federal laws and policies most frequently encountered by public land and resource managers. Students will learn the goals and requirements of laws such as the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the Endangered Species Act (ESA), the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), and the Clean Water Act (CWA). The course will also discuss laws and policies associated with protecting wetlands, floodplains, archeological resources, migratory birds, and wilderness.
